By submitting a nomination form, you are indicating your willingness and agreement to actively participate in face-to-face meetings and conference calls.

Periodic Review team members should expect to invest an average of approximately 10 hours per month for approximately 12 months to support this project. The first face-to-face meeting is tentatively planned for August 2017 in Atlanta, with one additional face-to-face meeting in North America, in addition to regular conference calls. Team members may also have supporting projects, either individually or by subgroup, to present to the larger team for discussion and review. Lastly, an important component of the Periodic Review effort is outreach. Members of the team will be expected to conduct industry outreach during the development process to support a successful project outcome.

The Standards Committee is expected to appoint members to the team in July 2017. Nominees will be notified shortly after they have been appointed.
