The proposed **Texas Reliability Entity Regional Standard Development Process (Texas RE RSDP)** is posted for a 45-day comment period through **8 p.m. Eastern, Friday, April 21, 2023**.

Regional Reliability Standards development procedures, such as the Texas RE RSDP, define a Regional Entity's process for development, revision, reaffirmation, and withdrawal of a Regional Reliability Standard.

Commenting

Use the [Standards Balloting and Commenting System \(SBS\)](#) to submit comments by **8 p.m. Eastern, Friday, April 21, 2023**. The comment form is posted on the [Regional Reliability Standards Under Development](#) page.

- *Contact NERC IT support directly at <https://support.nerc.net/> (Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. Eastern) for problems regarding accessing the SBS due to a forgotten password, incorrect credential error messages, or system lock-out.*
- *Passwords expire every **6 months** and must be reset.*
- *The SBS **is not** supported for use on mobile devices.*
- *Please be mindful of ballot and comment period closing dates. We ask to **allow at least 48 hours** for NERC support staff to assist with inquiries. Therefore, it is recommended that users try logging into their SBS accounts **prior to the last day** of a comment/ballot period.*
