On November 16, 2018, North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) submitted a compliance filing on amendments to NERC's Rules of Procedure to restore sections 603, 604, and 605, as well as correct typographical errors in sections 600 and 900, in accordance with the Commission's July 19, 2018 order.¹

Notice of this filing was published in the *Federal Register*, with protests and interventions due on or before December 7, 2018. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. 18 C.F.R. § 385.214. No adverse comments were received.

NERC's uncontested filing is accepted pursuant to the relevant authority delegated to the Director, Office of Energy Market Regulation, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307.

This action shall not be construed as approving any other application, including proposed revisions of Electric Reliability Organization or Regional Entity rules or procedures pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 375.307(a)(2)(vi). This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents. Such action shall not be deemed as recognition of any claimed right or obligation associated therewith and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders that have been or may
