Briefly describe the nominee's experience and qualifications to serve on the RISC:

Devon holds over 10 years of experience with a publicly-owned electric utility (Taunton Municipal Lighting Plant, Taunton MA) that was registered as a DP, TO, GO, and GOP. As a small (150 MW peak load) utility with these registrations, Devon has always provided a unique industry perspective to various working groups and committees within the ERO, such as with the NERC Electric-Gas Working Group, the Planning Committee prior to disbandment, his membership on the Compliance and Certification Committee, and his leadership on the 2019-04 SDT.
