Meeting Minutes Standards Committee Process Subcommittee

May 14, 2024 | 1:00 – 2:30 p.m. Eastern

Introduction and Chair's Remarks

Standards Committee Process Subcommittee (SCPS) Chair T. Brumfield called the duly noticed meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. Eastern and welcomed the members and observers. Quorum was achieved as seven of the nine members were present.

S. Bodkin raised a question on quorum, proposed expanding SCPS membership in an effort for additional members to participate. T. Brumfield responded his intention to conduct discussion on that topic towards the end of the SCPS meeting.

NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines and Public Announcement

L. Anderson, NERC staff, reviewed the NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines, the public meeting announcement, and referenced the new NERC Participant Conduct Policy that was included in the announcement package.

Review Meeting Agenda (Item 1)

T. Brumfield reviewed the meeting agenda with members and attendees. Motion to approve by S. Bodkin, seconded by D. Hammons. There were no objections, and the agenda was approved by unanimous consent.

Consent Agenda (Item 2)

The meeting minutes from March 20, 2024 were reviewed. No corrections were proposed. Motion to approve by K. Crist, seconded by M. Weber. Approved unanimously by members with no abstentions.

Discuss Standards Resource Documents (Item 3)

D. Hammons gave an overview of the Standards Resource Documents tracking list. Updates were made to the Standards Resource Documents to account for documents either being reviewed or revised. There were two new documents that were approaching their due dates. These documents were *Standards Committee Process Subcommittee (SCPS) Scope* and *Technical Rationale for Reliability Standards*. D. Hammons listed reminded SCPS members and observers that the two review teams assigned on February 20, 2024 would be combined into one team to review both documents. D. Hammons concluded the update.

S. Bodkin inquired about documents to be reviewed in the next six months. D. Hammons responded that the two listed in her update. D. Hammons suggested that if the SCPS members have any additional suggestions to improve the Standards Resource Documents tracking list and make it more user friendly, that she would take those suggestions and work with L. Anderson to make those revisions.

Resource Document Review Subgroup - Discussion (Item 4)



L. Anderson inquired into who would be assigned to lead this subgroup. T. Brumfield volunteered to take the lead in setting up the initial meeting and then will discuss a subgroup lead, if necessary.

Discussion - (Item 5)

- S. Bodkin brought forward a discussion regarding Order No. 901 workload and how the SCPS could support this work. S. Brumfield will take this to NERC staff for discussion. L. Anderson suggested members, independent of the SCPS, could support Order No. 901 workload by volunteering to participate on quality review teams.
- T. Brumfield began discussion on outreach to solicit new members for the SCPS. S. Bodkin brought forward the suggestion to reach out in the weekly Standards, Compliance, and Enforcement Bulletin. L. Anderson suggested looking at the process to solicit new SCPS members and conduct a discussion with T. Brumfield ahead of the June 2024 meeting.
- M. Weber announced he would not be able to attend the June 2024 meeting, but will try to assign a proxy.
- S. Rueckert announced he will have a proxy for the June 2024 meeting.
