Welcome to Minneapolis for the 13th annual GridSecCon security conference, co-hosted by the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC), the Electricity Information Sharing and Analysis Center (E-ISAC), and the Midwest Reliability Organization (MRO).

You are joining more than 600 of your security peers for three days of learning, collaboration, and networking. GridSecCon features an agenda of sessions led by top cyber and physical security experts on the evolving threat landscape, effective threat mitigation programs, best practices, and more. The event also offers networking opportunities, a space to interact with vendors, and most importantly, a forum to learn from each other.

The Electric Reliability Organization (ERO) Enterprise launched GridSecCon more than a decade ago to provide the industry with a forum for collectively learning and sharing information to better secure the North American bulk power system (BPS).

Since then, threats to the BPS have evolved in ways that early GridSecCon attendees could scarcely have imagined. In 2024, the security of the grid has captured the attention of the public, generating major news stories, government hearings, and discourse among industry leaders. Concerns about potential threats around the U.S. elections have also heightened this focus.

The electric industry faces complex cyber and physical security threats driven by the tactics, tools, and techniques of highly motivated threat actors, including nation-states and domestic violent extremists. Malware, ransomware, and other cyber threats are constantly evolving, jeopardizing both operational and information technology systems. Protecting physical infrastructure from a wide range of threats, such as unmanned aerial vehicles and ballistic attacks on substations, has stretched security teams at utilities large and small.

Despite these challenges, through our collective expertise and information-sharing between industry, government, and vendors, we have successfully worked together to respond to these threats. We also continue to prepare for future challenges, be it artificial intelligence (AI), civil unrest, or unexpected weather, with solutions that are secure-by-design and adaptable.
