

# Meeting Notes Project 2023-06 CIP-014 Risk Assessment Refinement Drafting Team

March 22, 2024 | 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Eastern

#### **Introduction and Chair's Remarks**

The meeting started at 10:01 a.m. Eastern. The Chair welcomed the Drafting Team (DT) members and the participants from the industry. The chair also announced that Darrel Grumman from Great River Energy resigned from the drafting team due to both his internal work assignment change and personal reason as of March 22, 2024. #### **NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines and Public Announcement**

The NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines, NERC Participant Conduct Policy, and the Public Announcement were presented and reviewed by the secretary.

## **Agenda Items**

## 1. Develop Draft of Standard, Implementation Plan, VRFs and VSLs

- a. The DT started with Requirement R1 and visited the timelines. The team agreed that keeping the list should be reviewed every 36 months. The DT also reviewed SAR work scop #2: Revise the risk assessment and clarify the case(s) used for the assessment to be tailored to the Requirement R1 in-service window and correct any discrepancies between the study period, frequency of study, and the base case(s) a Transmission Owner uses. If the Transmission Owner's list from R1 does not contain any applicable Transmission station(s) or Transmission substation(s), then no additional actions are required to fulfill the remainder of the Standard.
- b. Shall/Must is strong given that entities will have to forecast 36 mo. out vs. current 24 months. A question was raised that it's a planning projection. If a sub gets accelerated into the 36-mo. period two years later, is that a violation? Could the previously unidentified sub be appended to the study and evaluated per subsequent requirements vs. having to accomplish everything with a new 36-mo. Projection?
- c. Proposed M1: Examples of acceptable evidence may include, but are not limited to, dated written or electronic documentation of the Transmission station(s) and Transmission substation(s) that meet the criteria in Applicability Section 4.1.1 as specified in Requirement R1.
- d. Proposed M2: Examples of evidence may include, but are not limited to, dated written or electronic documentation specifying the methodology used to determine the areas of impact (locus/loci) to evaluate the loss of each of the Transmission Owner's applicable Transmission station(s) and Transmission substation(s) from a physical attack at a single location in accordance with Requirement R2.
