 - c. Frank noted that 20% will provide appropriate coverage.
- d. Requirement R6, part 6.1 Transformers that have a low-side operating voltage of 100kV or above.
 - a. The Team discussed removing this part but determined that if it was removed the Requirement would unintentionally include directly connected GSUs.
