A formal comment period for **BAL-012-1 – Operating Reserve Policy** is open through 8 p.m. Eastern on Monday, January 14, 2013. Ballots pools are being formed through 8 a.m. Eastern on Thursday, **January 3, 2012**. In consideration of the holidays, the ballot pool window has been extended a few days beyond the typical 30-day period.

Phase 1 of Balancing Authority Reliability-based Controls: Reserves is comprised of four standards – BAL-001-1, BAL-002-2, BAL-012-1 and BAL-013-1. This comment period and initial ballot pertains to BAL-012-1 - Operating Reserve Policy. The remaining standards in this project will be addressed in a separate comment period and initial ballot.

Instructions for Joining Ballot Pool

Ballots pools are being formed for the standard and non-binding poll for BAL-012-1. Registered Ballot Body members must join both ballot pools to be eligible to vote in the balloting of BAL-012-1 and to submit an opinion for the non-binding poll of the associated VRFs and VSLs. An initial ballot of the standard and non-binding poll of the associated VRF/VSLs will be conducted Friday, January 4, 2013 through 8 p.m. Eastern on Monday, January 14, 2013.

Background

The NERC Standards Committee approved the merger of Project 2007-05 Balancing Authority Controls and Project 2007-18 Reliability-based Control as Project 2010-14 Balancing Authority Reliability-based Controls on July 28, 2010. The NERC Standards Committee also approved the separation of Project 2010-14 Balancing Authority Reliability-based Controls into two phases and moving Phase 1 (Project 2010-14.1 Balancing Authority Reliability-based Controls – Reserves) into formal standards development on July 13, 2011. The Project 2010-14.1 Phase 1 proposes revisions to BAL-001-0.1a Real Power Balancing Control Performance and BAL-002-1 Disturbance Control Performance. The project also proposes two new standards, BAL-012-1 Operating Reserve Policy and BAL-013-1 Large Loss of Load Performance. This posting will be for a formal comment period and initial ballot of BAL-012-1. This standard will address the FERC Order 693 Directive for development of a continent wide Contingency Reserve standard. The standard also proposes to require development of a policy for Regulating and Frequency Responsive Reserves.

The four standards within Project 2010-14.1 are an important part of the ERO's strategic goal to develop technically sufficient standards with requirements that provide clear and unambiguous performance expectations and reliability benefits.
