

Meeting Notes Project 2022-05 Modifications to CIP-008 Reporting Threshold Drafting Team

June 23, 2025 | 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. Eastern

Review NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines and Public Announcement

Jason Snider, NERC staff, called attention to the NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines and the public meeting notice.

Roll Call and Determination of Quorum

A team roll call was taken and it was determined that quorum had not been achieved initially, but after some time more members joined, and quorum was established. The member attendance sheet is attached as attachment 1.

Opening Remarks

S. Koller, vice chair, welcomed the group and gave an overview of the goals for the call.

Project updates

S. Koller suggested the group review the <u>CIP-008 TR language</u> side by side with the <u>Current draft of CIP-008</u>. The group began with R1, noting that while there was agreement in the intent, R1.1 may be better reworded. After some discussion, the group revised the language to read:

"Intake, analyze, and classify Events of Interest, inclusive of security-focused criteria that ensures events with actionable intelligence are investigated."

The group agreed that this language matched the intent of ensuring that events that should be reported are not evaluated out of the criteria for reporting due to inconsistent evaluations.

The drafting team spent some time discussing the technical rationale provided for the <u>definitions</u>, wordsmithing the language in the Technical Rationale to include "to compromise the confidentially, integrity, or availability of systems or data".

Minor changes were also made to R4 to better identify what information is shared.

S. Koller reminded the drafting team that the goal was to conduct an informal posting in July to gauge industry's alignment with the progress on the draft and stressed the need for the team to review and provide feedback on the following documents:
