UPDATED Electromagnetic Transient Modeling Task Force (EMTTF) Workplan Item 4 Survey Available

To promote the use of electromagnetic transient (EMT) modeling and studies, the EMTTF has a dedicated team working on workplan item 4: White Paper: Case Study on Adoption of EMT Modeling and Studies in Interconnection and Planning Studies for BPS-connected IBRs. This study investigates best practices among system operators and transmission planners (Transmission Planners and Planning Coordinators) for interconnection and planning studies of inverter-based resources (IBRs) within the bulk power system (BPS). The EMTTF plans to publish this whitepaper based on its findings to enhance the understanding and utilization of EMT modeling in addressing the challenges and opportunities in the energy landscape with high penetration of IBRs.

This <u>questionnaire</u> is designed to understand your organization's approaches, successes, challenges, and future direction regarding EMT modeling and studies for IBRs. Your insights will contribute to creating a comprehensive resource to help the energy industry optimize the integration and planning of these resources, promoting a more resilient and sustainable power system.
