#### **NEW** Project 2023-04 – Modifications to CIP-003 Final Documents Posted

The drafting team is posting the <u>final documents</u> of CIP-003-11 – Cyber Security – Security Management Controls, but not conducting a final ballot, per the Standard Processes Manual (SPM) section 4.13. Consistent with these requirements, the last ballot received 93.89% approval. The drafting team has made a good faith effort to resolve objections and responded to comments in writing, including making minor corrections to two of the non-mandatory and enforceable sections of the standard. The <u>Ballot Results</u> page provides the detailed voting results from the previous ballot. CIP-003-11 will be presented to the NERC Board at the December Board of Trustees meeting.

#### **NEW ERO Enterprise Webinar – Registered Entity Refresher Training –** Align Enforcement and Mitigation Modules

On December 4, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Eastern, the ERO Enterprise will host a refresher training for Registered Entities on how to use the Enforcement and Mitigation modules in Align. Registration is required for this training and is being offered to the Registered Entities that use Align.

The training is designed to for registered entities to walk through:

- Creating and submitting a Finding to the CEA
- Providing updates to that Finding
- Creating and submitting a Mitigation record
- Managing the milestones
- Receiving and responding to Requests for Information
- Receiving and responding to Disposition Notifications
- Understanding where noncompliance and mitigation are in the process.

#### **OTHER NEWS**

#### **NEW NERC Posts Winter Reliability Assessment**

NERC's <u>2024–2025 *Winter Reliability Assessment*</u> finds that while regulatory and industry initiatives have improved winter readiness, many parts of North America are once again at an elevated risk of energy shortfalls under extreme conditions. The findings are largely driven by issues related to natural gas production and delivery coupled with potential limited regional pipeline capacity in the U.S. Mid-Atlantic and Northeast, robust load growth that continues to surpass growth in dispatchable resources, and retirements in thermal generation resources. Similar to last year, no areas are identified as having a high risk of energy shortfalls in extreme weather conditions and all areas are expected to have adequate resources under normal winter peak load conditions.

#### **NEW NERC Releases IBR Registration Resources for New Registrants**

Over the past six years, system events have demonstrated that inverter-based resources (IBR) are having a major impact on generation, transmission, and distribution systems. These resources play a critical role in the transition to a more resilient and sustainable future energy landscape, but their unique characteristics present new challenges for grid reliability and stability. As part of its IBR Strategy, NERC is dedicated to identifying and addressing challenges associated with IBRs, sharing risk mitigation techniques with industry, and providing best practices and education. <u>Full Announcement</u>.

# **NEW Sunshine Act Agenda Posted for Upcoming FERC Open Meeting**

FERC released the Sunshine Act open <u>agenda</u> for its upcoming November 21, 2024 open meeting. Although not directly an FPA Section 215 item, Item E-1 is related to Order No. 1920, which is subject to various petitions for review in U.S. Circuit Courts of Appeals. NERC submitted comments in response to the ANOPR and NOPR leading up to issuance of Order No. 1920.

#### **NEW NERC Filing**

On November 15, 2024, NERC submitted an unaudited <u>report</u> of NERC's budget-to-actual variance information for the third quarter of 2024.
