disturbance-based playback including event triggering and data capture. Time commitments for most projects include up to two face-to-face



meetings per quarter (on average two full working days each meeting) with conference calls scheduled as needed. Members of the team will be expected to conduct industry outreach during the development process to support a successful project outcome.

<u>This project is identified as high priority at this time.</u> The project has a FERC deadline of November 4, 2025. To meet this deadline, the team will meet regularly, up to three times a week on conference calls, with face-to-face meetings scheduled as the members' schedule allows, up to once a quarter. ## ERO Enterprise Webinar – Registered Entity Refresher Training – Align Enforcement and Mitigation Modules

On December 4, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Eastern, the ERO Enterprise will host a refresher training for Registered Entities on how to use the Enforcement and Mitigation modules in Align. Registration is required for this training and is being offered to the Registered Entities that use Align. The training is designed to for registered entities to walk through:

- Creating and submitting a Finding to the CEA
- Providing updates to that Finding
- Creating and submitting a Mitigation record
- Managing the milestones
- Receiving and responding to Requests For Information
- Receiving and responding to Disposition Notifications
- Understanding where the noncompliance and mitigation are in the process.

The training will be focused on using the Align system in the Enforcement and Mitigation modules; presenters will not review regional processes. The training will be recorded and any questions received during the training will be answered in a FAQ document following the webinar.

### **NEW NERC Posts AI/Machine Learning White Paper**

NERC has posted <u>Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning in Real-Time System Operations Whitepaper</u>. The purpose of this Whitepaper is to provide an overview of the advancement in artificial intelligence and machine learning (AI/ML) technologies and their applications in real-time system operations. It offers a foundation for understanding the transformative role of AI/ML in real-time operations and aims to stimulate further research and development in this area.

# **NEW** Proposed Data Request Response to Comments – Cold Weather Generator Data Collection

Pursuant to NERC Rules of Procedure Section 1600, NERC posted a proposed data request regarding generators' operation during cold weather for a 45-day comment period from June 14, 2024 to July 29, 2024. NERC reviewed comments and revised the proposed data request. For the next steps, NERC must seek NERC Board of Trustees authorization prior to issuing the data request. The proposed data request is in response to a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission directive to develop a plan to collect data on the winterization of generating units and to submit an annual informational filing on the analysis of the data. <u>Mock Data Set</u>.
