NEW Call for Abstracts: GridSecCon 2025

NERC, the Electricity Information Sharing and Analysis Center (E-ISAC), and WECC announced a call for abstracts for GridSecCon 2025, which takes place October 7-10 at the MGM Grand in Las Vegas. As these organizations continue to advance the dialog on cyber security, physical security, and other relevant industry trends, grid security professionals and decision makers, asset owners and operators, and experts from industry and government are invited to share insights and best practices.

Themes: Submissions across a broad range of topics are encouraged, including but not limited to cyber security, physical security, and emerging trends and challenges within the electric sector such as ransomware, drones, AI, and more.

Format: Abstracts should be limited to 350 words, outlining the main objectives, significant themes, and overall relevance to the conference.

Deadline: Friday, April 4 by 11:59 p.m. Eastern.

Abstracts will be evaluated by a panel of experts and selected based on their relevance, originality, and clarity. Notification of acceptance will be sent by April 28.
