NEW Draft Reliability Guideline: Recommended Approaches for UFLS Program Design with Increasing Penetrations of DERs The NERC System Planning Impacts of DER Working Group (SPIDERWG) is currently conducting a triennial review of the Reliability Guideline on UFLS Program Design in the context of increasing Distributed Energy Resource (DER) penetration. The NERC Reliability and Security Technical Committee (RSTC) has authorized the guideline for a public comment period lasting 45 days, from March 17, 2025, to May 1, 2025. Additionally, there is a survey to assess the guideline's effectiveness. NEW Posted: Findings from Recommendation to Industry

On April 1, 2025 NERC posted a <u>report</u> summarizing the key findings from the Level 2 Recommendation to Industry: <u>Inverter-Based Resource Model Quality Deficiencies Alert</u>, which was issued on September 2, 2024 to Generator Owners (GO), Transmission Planners (TP), and Planning Coordinators (PC). The alert included numerous recommendations for modeling best practices and a series of questions, that were intended to gather dynamic modeling information from BES-connected IBR GOs, TPs, and PCs to understand the extent of condition of dynamic modeling deficiencies for IBR. The aggregated report is being posted for awareness to help inform industry what additional actions are necessary to mitigate observed deficiencies. NEW Materials Posted: 2025 Reliability Leadership Summit

<u>Recordings</u> and <u>presentation</u> from the Reliability Leadership Summit on February 27, 2025 in Washington, D.C are now available. The day-long summit focused on emerging reliability issues and their impacts on the operation of the bulk power system. Feedback and observations from the event will be included in an *ERO Reliability Risk Priorities Report*, which will guide NERC's work plan on key priorities.

NEW Request for Nominations: Credential Maintenance Working Group

The NERC System Operator Certification Program is holding an open nomination beginning April 3 until May 16, 2025 to fill three vacancies on the Credential Maintenance Working Group (CMWG). The successful candidate is expected to serve a two-year term. The Personnel Certification Governance Committee Nomination Task Force & CMWG Chair will consider nominees with the following qualifications:

- Experience in the electric utility industry. Parallel experience of training in the electric utility industry will suffice for both training and industry experience
- Experience in NERC Certified system operator training
- Advanced training expertise, preferably in the bulk transmission system and Bulk Electric System operations
- Knowledge and experience applying a systematic approach to training
- Knowledge regarding reliable operations within their organizations.



Responsibilities include protecting the integrity and independence of the Credential Maintenance Program, attendance and participation in four quarterly meetings held in-person or virtually, participation in various conference calls and task force group tasks.
